Course Details:

- Rhythm clapping: Students will understand dotted rhythm and full range of rhythm from whole note to semiquavers through clapping. Enhancing sightreading skills and accuracy after lessons through simple clapping approach.
- Singing: One part singing and two-part singing in a sightreading manner. Student are expected to learn singing techniques and ensemble skills through singing.
 Some of the famous melody or excerpt from the classics will be covered during classes.
- Composer Appreciation: Week 1: Discovering stories between JS Bach and his sons. listen to some music and understand the similarities and different through their musical style and approach. Week 2: Discovering stories between Mozart Beethoven and Haydn, listen to some music and understand the similarities and different through their musical style and approach.
- Aural dictation: Student are expected to hear the difference between steps and skips, different colour of major and minor, dynamics and some basic melody dictation. Student could learn from creating their own exercises through testing other students.
- I am Little Composer: Student are divided into two groups, each learning how to write a melody line while others try to create another voices/line to harmonize the melody line. Student also expected to learn how to compose a simple melody selected from a given Alberti bass.
- **Performance class:** Each student will play a song on any instruments, with a small speech and music sharing regarding the composer or describing their stylistic approach. Student are expected to learn the how to communicate while on stage through music sharing/ performance in front of a group of supportive audience.
- Quiz games: Through a score system we encourage students to support each other and be active during classes. These quizzes and games including aural dictation, composer quizzes, clapping challenge, scales battle etc.
